Three months after the attacks on September 11th, and community spirit is going strong.

A donation wasn't enough for Stephen Galvin from Wolcott, so he thought long and hard about how to pay permanent tribute to the victims of the attacks.

After several designs and research of more than 1,700 flags, Stephen and his wife designed "Their Flag". They're hoping to make it the official flag in remembrance of 9-11.

"Twenty to twenty-five years from now, to have something to look at point at, that was my uncle, that was my dad, the next generation can say they knew the person," said Stephen Galvin.

Each element of the flag represents the tragedy. The black represents sorrow, the blue represents the colors of the state flag for each state where a plane was downed and each star represents victims that innocently lost their lives in Pennsylvania, Washington D.C., and New York City.

Stephen and his family will travel to New York City today to show the flag to firefighters and police. They hope that public input will make the flag "official".

All flag sales will go to various 9-11-relief efforts.
