Stephen and Joanne Galvin created a flag in honor of those who perished in the September 11th attacks.

The couple did not lose any loved ones in the tragedy, but the heartache they felt moved them to reach out to those who did.

"We started thinking about what we could do to provide money for the relief efforts," said Joanne Galvin. "We thought if we designed a flag and could sell it and send the proceeds, we could provide donations for a long time."

Senator Mike Nozzolio is trying to make the Galvin flag an official state flag. Already it's flown in 16 states and two countries.

The flag proposal could go to the legislature as soon as next week.
